Some Successes

 99% -100% grad rate over past two years



- Low Chronic Absentee Rate at
 4%
- Many positive perceptions by students, staff and families in 2021 stakeholder surveys about campus climate, pathways, and college preparation programs

Some Challenges

• Low ELA and Math achievement



- Low College/Career Preparation rate 51% prepared
- High suspension rate at 14% in 2019 and 9% in 2020

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Stakeholder Engagement

- Multiple student surveys, parent/family surveys, town hall meetings, staff meetings, grade level team meetings
- Highest positive perceptions regarding school climate: 94% of families, 97% of staff and 93% of students said that they school is safe and 94%, 95%, and 94% feel welcome at school
- High positive perceptions of programs for students: athletics (90%, 97%, and 92% respectively), support for English Learner Students (93%, 95%, and 91% respectively), providing mental health supports for students (85%, 97%, and 80% respectively)
- High positive perceptions for preparing students for college: 94%, 77%, and 89%
