- Looked for a diverse population, both socio-economic, gender and cultural identity





- Culture Climate: Very diverse: culturally, race, sexual orientation
  - All students felt safe
  - Believe there are just a few students who are bullies

- Average amount of time on site: 5 years
- Use of technology on a daily basis
- Operations:
  - Positive:Outdoor campus, Patio out at lunch, small campus, office hours,
  - Concerns: Poor fields or sports, would like a turf field, bathroom stalls need fixing, too many roaming teachers, Bigger additional Gym
- Instruction: Students prefer visual learning, project based learning and walking through steps and a recap of information before moving on.
  - Positive: One on one instruction, content made interesting, majority of students feel challenged with content, classroom environments, most teachers are engaging
  - Concerns:Lack of engagement, pace is often fast, unable to concentrate in classroom with little classroom management
- Sports: More announcements made, updated equipment and fields
- College: All students plan on attending



#### Culture Climate

- Safety: Students feel safe, yet would like to engage in safety trainings.
