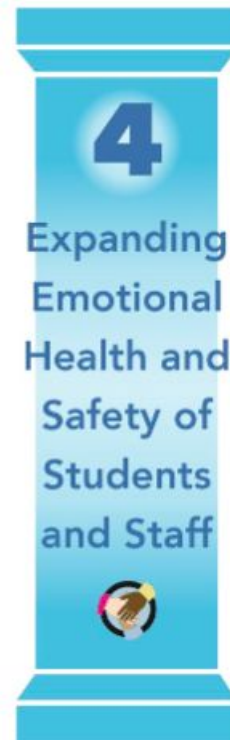

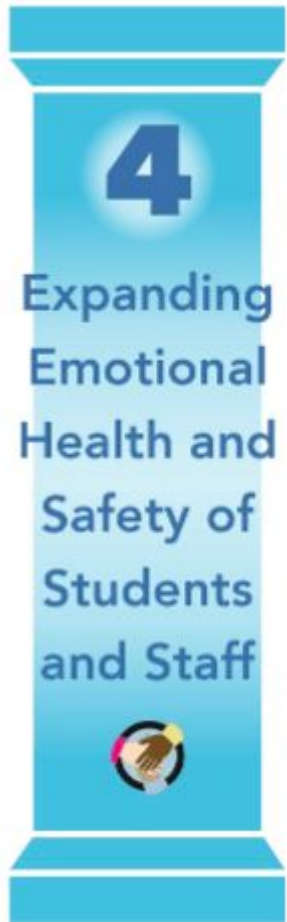


Eliminating the Digital Divide



- LGA conducted Technology checkout days for all students on 3/27, 3/31 and 4/1
 - We issued 375 chromebooks to our families (48% of our student population)
 - We also issued 8 hotspots for families lacking a stable connection to the internet
- As a huge shoutout to my administrative team we also delivered chromebooks directly to the homes of students who missed the checkout days
- Students are keeping these chromebooks as we transition into the 20-21 school year
- LGA will be purchasing roughly 400 chromebooks to replace antiquated technology
 - LGA Currently has over a thousand chromebooks campus-wide and will remain 1-1

Expanding Emotional Supports



- As of April 5th LGA had made some form of contact with all of its families
- We had weekly recurring meetings with our teachers. Discussed students that teachers were concerned about
- Met with Counselors and School Psychologist weekly to discuss communication with families
 - Created a mental health tracking sheet, families identified were offered services during these check-ins
- LGA's School psychologist created a mental health coping skills video that included LGA staff and what they do to deal with stress

Feeding Students



With the continued support of the amazing NUSD Nutrition Services all LGA students will continue to be fed through the summer and into the 20-21 school year.

Educational Options



- Independent study (short term and longer term is an option). If parents can and are willing to play an active roll, it is an option with direct support from a credentialed teacher
- 60%-85% (estimates) of students can be in some classrooms with social distancing or physical barriers (that could go higher as situation changes)
- Hybrid learning may be an option and may be needed in larger classroom settings
- This is all fluid, approaching COVID-19 is consistently inconsistent and based on DATE and TIME of science, progress and assumptions

- Protective barriers are a possible solution.
- LGA will look at slimming down rooms by removing large furniture
- Most LGA classrooms have built in cabinets and bookshelves which limit the available floor space for desks
- HS school class size target is 36 to 1, over 36 results in overage costs

Health and Safety



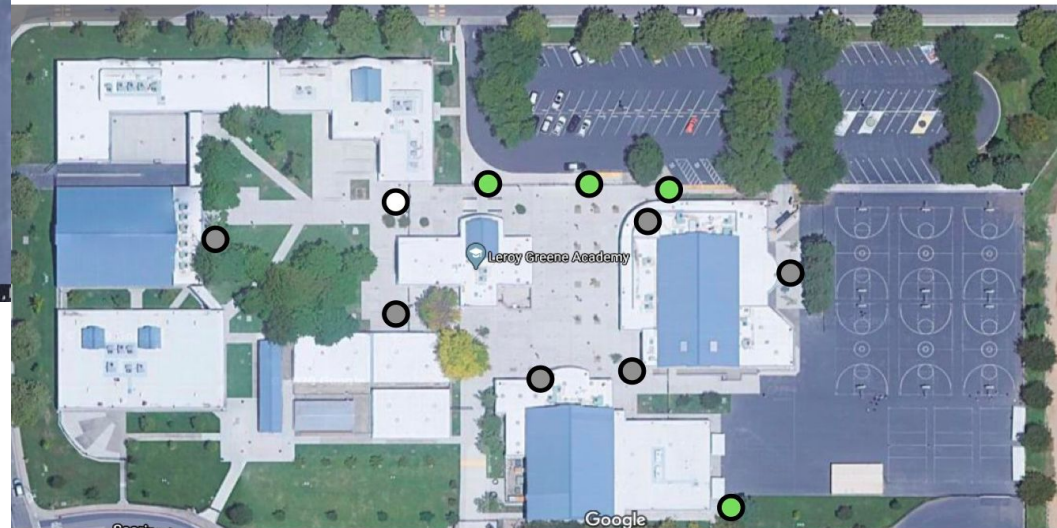
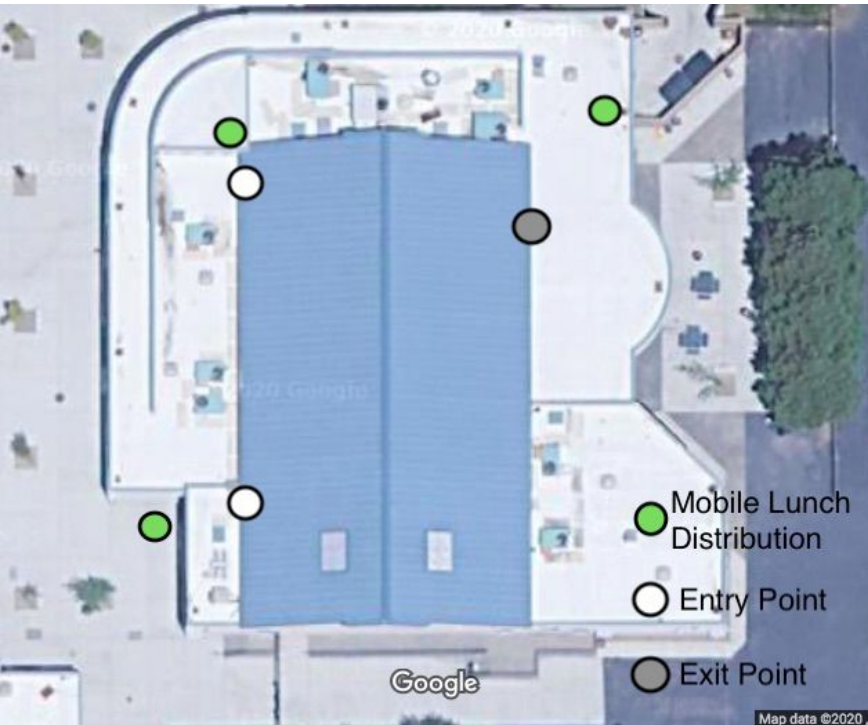
- Parents will screen at home... temperatures will not be taken on site

- We will work to put together a plan of how students should move through the hallways during passing periods

- Currently discussing plans for student arrival in the morning
- Will work with student leaders to help train/film other students on processes on appropriate hygiene
