
Educational Partner Engagement


- Significant amount of engagement in 2022-2023 around educational programs, public health, and social emotional supports

- Lower rates of positive perceptions for LGA providing opportunities for students to connect to mentors and volunteer in the community, as well as for providing effective programs to help English Learners and high achieving students
